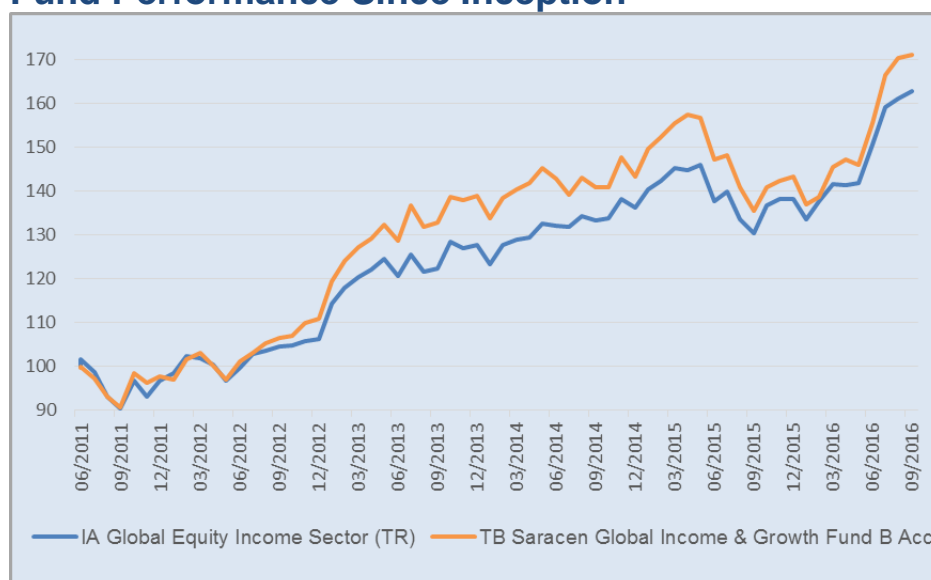


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Fund Objective and Policy

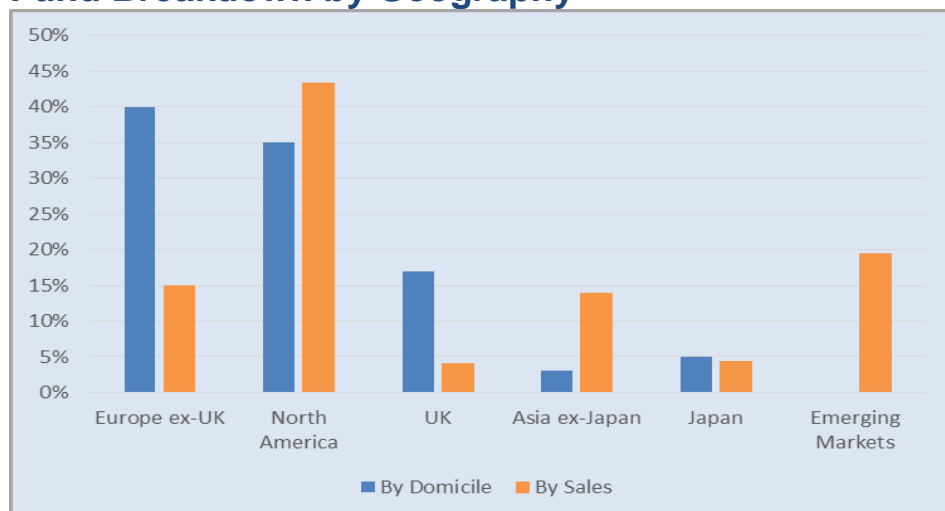

Monthly Commentary

▶ Performance

This month, the total return for SGIG was +0.5%, compared to +0.3% for the IA Global Equity Income sector. The fund has now delivered a return of +72% since inception.

▶ FX

Sterling movements during the month had a positive impact on performance. Sterling was approximately 1.5% - 2% weaker against the USD, EUR and CHF.

▶ Positive

September was a very quiet month for corporate news flow with markets more focussed on monetary policy decisions across the globe and the latest OPEC meeting. Ashmore (-2%), which was the only company in our portfolio to report numbers, delivered a solid statement and upbeat outlook announcement. They highlighted both the absolute valuation opportunities in EM Debt and the relative opportunity when compared to yields on offer in developed markets. They are also confident of returning to net positive flows over the next 6-12 months. Rio Tinto (+13%) had a good month as analysts upgraded their forecasts for the higher than expected commodity prices. Apple (+7%) performed strongly after the successful launch of the new iPhone 7.

▶ Negative

The well documented issues at Deutsche Bank had a knock-on effect to the rest of the European bank sector. Our holding in UBS (-9%) performed poorly. BMW (-7%) and Hugo Boss (-11%) were also weak.

▶ Portfolio Activity

We bought Asahi Group during the month. Please see the Quarterly report for further details.
